

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION, WEATHER & POPULATION

The strategic and aesthetic strait that separates the two coasts of Istanbul together with the two continents is the Bosporus which is the first gate from the Black Sea to the Aegean and then onto the Mediterranean. Istanbul is the unique city in the world bridging two continents, Europe and Asia.
